MEMBERSHIP in PPSREA

1. **Annual (Active):** All retired employees of the School District of Philadelphia who receive a pension from the Pennsylvania School Employees Retirement System (PSERS) are eligible for membership. Dues paid annually.
2. **Life:** All retired employees of the School District of Philadelphia who receive a pension from the Pennsylvania School Employees Retirement System (PSERS) are eligible for membership. Dues paid once.
3. **Associate:** Any current employee of the School District who is 55 years of age or older or any spouse of an active member. Dues paid annually.
