GLEN R. GRELL

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM (PSERS) INVITED AS FALL LUNCHEON KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Mr. Grell is the Executive Director of the Public School Employees' Retirement Systems (PSERS), a \$50.2 billion public pension system headquartered in Harrisburg, PA and currently the 20th largest state-sponsored defined benefit public pension fund in the nation with a membership of nearly 260,000 active school employees and nearly 220,00 retirees. Prior to being named

Executive Director, Mr. Grell served as the elected State Representative for the 87th District in the House of Representatives, which includes several communities in Eastern Cumberland County. He was first elected to the Pennsylvania House of Representatives in 2004.

During his tenure in the House of Representatives, Mr. Grell was the prime sponsor or House floor leader on legislation addressing many important matters, including: the 2010 pension reform; eminent domain; the 2012 Justice Reinvestment Initiative for corrections reform; revisions to the Uniform Commercial Code on secured transactions; a recodification of the Notary Public Law; and tort reform. Prior to his election, Mr. Grell was an attorney in private practice in Central Pennsylvania.

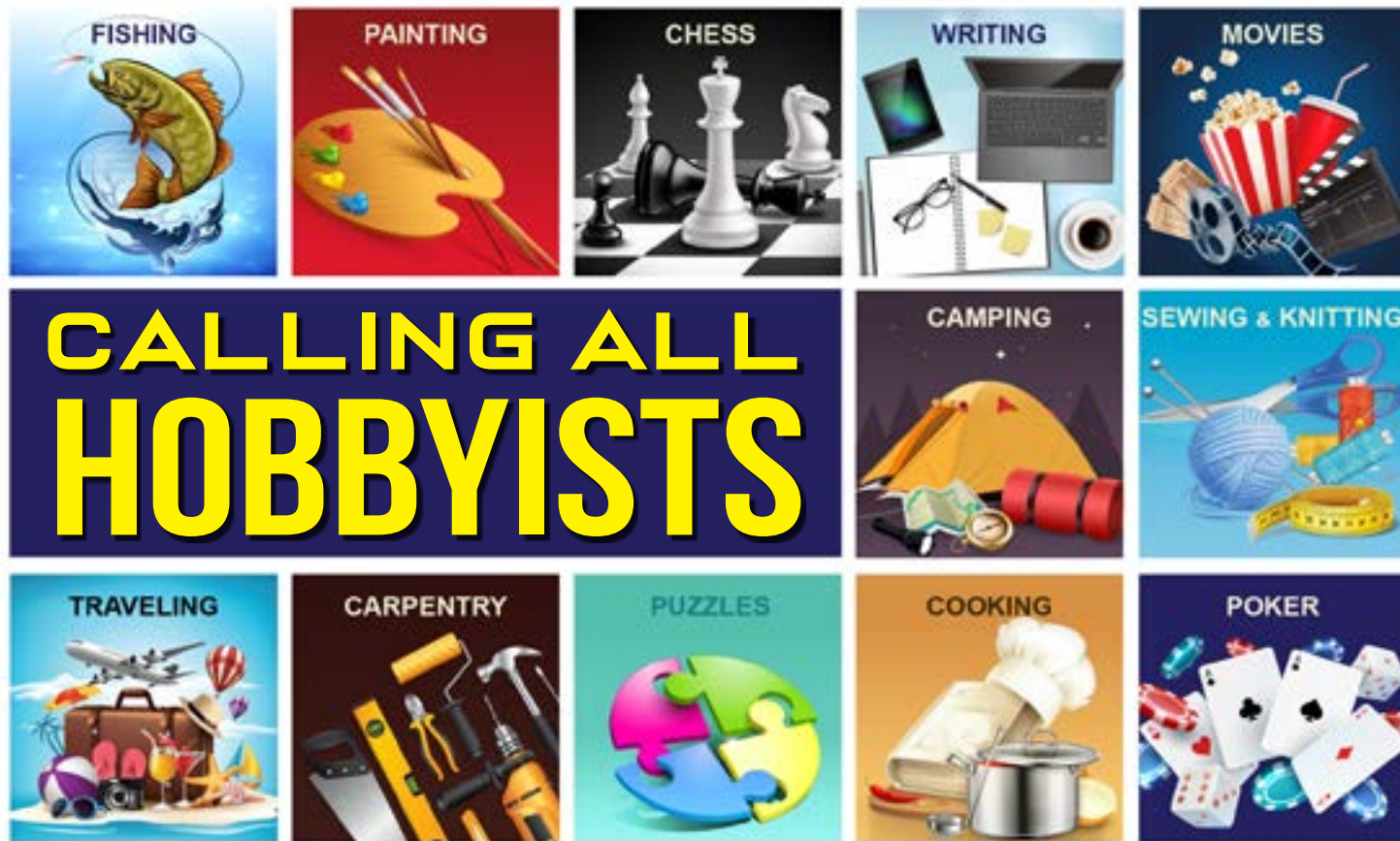
